On your Station Log you should make a note of the tower light sensing circuitry problem, and that your engineer has been informed and will be working on the issue. You should also note that you have checked the lights when the alarm is issued, and that the lights have been on every time. To be technically correct, you should either:

1) Turn the lights on and leave them on. This guarantees that they are on. They should still be periodically (per week) visually checked.

or

2) Visually check the lights every day and make note of it in the Station Log.

It sounds like the lights are transitioning correctly, but that the alarm circuit is not working properly. You are *probably* OK depending on the circuit to switch them on and off, but without at least an occasional visual check, you can't be certain. Whatever you do, make a note in the Station Log.

Let me know when you are ready to have me troubleshoot this. I would need to be out there at least an hour before sunset so I can do a visual and operational check of the lighting circuits, then observe how they perform at sunset.
