#### Education

**07/13/2022 - En el Dia a Dia (60 minutes)**

**Host: Ricardo and Lucia Luzondo**

The couple discussed the differences between an abortion and a miscarriage. With the revocation of Roe vs Wade the couple discussed what impact this has to the community and how this decision builds a culture of life.
