Education

4-26-22 Defiende la Vida Host Adolfo Castaneda. 60 minutes. Adolfo focused on the original meaning of Christian sexuality and marriage. He shared points on how to live a pure life that respects everyone's dignity.

6-14-22 Conecta2 Host Religious Sisters Comunicadoras del Padre Celestial. 60 minutes. They began a segment educating the audience on the gifts of the Holy Spirit. 5-25-22 En el Dia a Dia Host Ricardo y Lucia. 60 minutes. Ricardo focused on the importance of prioritizing the bodies' health. He warned to not disregard the body and gave research proven tips on how to take care of the body. He emphasized the importance of parents to lead by example.

6-2-22 Alegre la Manana Host Martin Arizmendi. 60 minutes. Martin invited family psychologist Gaby Satarino. She discussed the various components of the human person – mind, body, and spirit. She explained each aspect and gave ways of keeping each area strong and healthy. She also discussed the common manifestation of ailments and how to remedy them.

4-28-22 Cara a Cara Host Alejandro Bermudez. 60 minutes. Alejandro selected questions sent in by listeners during the week. He researched the pre-selected questions and discussed the answer. The questions ranged from topics of politics, social justice, faith, and family dynamics.
