Mayors from Arkansas and across the country voiced concerns on the nation's infrastructure during the annual National League of Cities' Congressional Congress.

The Arkansas Democrat Gazette reports mayors across the nation hope the White House will provide increased funding on roads, highways and bridges.

More than two thousand mayors, city council members and others attended last week's conference. President Donald Trump's 2020 budget blueprint calls for full funding of the Highway Trust Fund, and 200 billion for "additional infrastructure investments."

However, the budget also calls for less funding to the U.S. Department of Transportation.
