The Department of Health says of the 52 deaths, 29 were confirmed to be from the disease, while 23 were likely. About 17-hundred new cases were reported of people testing positive for the virus. In a statement, Governor Asa Hutchinson noted that's about 700 fewer than the same time last week. There were also 27-hundred fewer active cases than the same day a week ago. Hutchinson suggested steps being taken to slow the virus "appear to be having an effect." Vaccine distribution continues to be a top priority, he said. The state reported receiving 12,700o doses in the previous 24 hours. Nearly 14,400 were administered. SOC.
