There will be a bake sale benefiting Arkansas Children's Hospital at noon Saturday at J & J Livestock Auction, 1813 S. Kings Highway, Texarkana, Texas.

The bake sale is part of Bill Waggoner's yearlong effort to raise money for ACH. He also has a trail ride planned for March 15 and 16 from Texarkana to Old Washington.

Waggoner has items donated and auctions them off throughout the year to raise money for the hospital.

"People give me horses. I've had 90 head of horses given to me that we've sold. We've auctioned off everything you can think of from wedding dresses to tattoos a donkey," he said.

Last year Waggoner raised \$10,000 for the hospital. In years past, he has raised as much as much as \$24,000.

"I work on it all year long. It's a full-time job for me, I'll tell you for sure," Waggoner said. "Every bit of the proceeds go to Arkansas Children's Hospital. We don't take a penny of it. That's what it's all about."

Waggoner became familiar with the hospital while taking his grandson TJ Waggoner there for treatment for a heart condition. TJ passed away in 2011.

"I spent many an hour in that hospital. It's a worthy cause. I'm 78 years old, and I'll be 79 in May. Somebody asked me the other day when I was going to quit. I'm gonna do it until I can't do it anymore," Waggoner said.
