The Arkansas Senate has passed a resolution to restrict term limits for state lawmakers to 12 years. If the resolution is passed by the House it will be added to the 2020 general election ballot. Republican Senator Alan Clark from Lonsdale sponsored the bill. He said the resolution has elements to appease proponents for and against term limits.
