Border Pete and Chuck Downing started the show with an update on the community meeting which took place on 4/10/19. It was the first organizational meeting of the newly ordered consolidated school district of the three towns of Athens, Grafton, and Westminster, VT. They let listeners and the community know the mood and opinions expressed at the meeting. They also explained that the meeting was recessed early before much was accomplished. Border Pete and Chuck informed listeners of the Judge's recent decisions in the Appeal case of the forced mergers. The decisions on the Vermont State's arguments to have the lawsuit closed ended with three counts being dropped and three to continue in court.
