Avoid the parking hassles when attending the Pecan Fe4stival on Saturday, November 3rd in downtown Florence!

A free Park & Ride shuttle service will be provided all day from four convenient locations. You can park your car, jump on the bus and you will be dropped off at the festival. Busses will depart every 15 minutes.

When you are ready to head home, simply go to one of the convenient bus pickup points at the Festival and catch the bus back to your car. It's FREE, the wait for a bus will be short and the service will run from 10:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.

The Park & Ride pickup points are as follows:

- The Florence Mall parking lot, enter by the Piggly Wiggly.
- The former Winn Dixie store parking lot 124 S. Cashua Drive
- The Big Lots parking lot 953 South Irby
- The parking area by the Florence Airport Highway 76E/West Palmetto

To identify parking area, look for the buss with the Park & Ride banner.

With over 50,000 attendees, the parking situation gets very tight in the downtown area. Festival organizers encourage festival goers to avoid the issues of parking at the event and utilize the shuttle bus.






