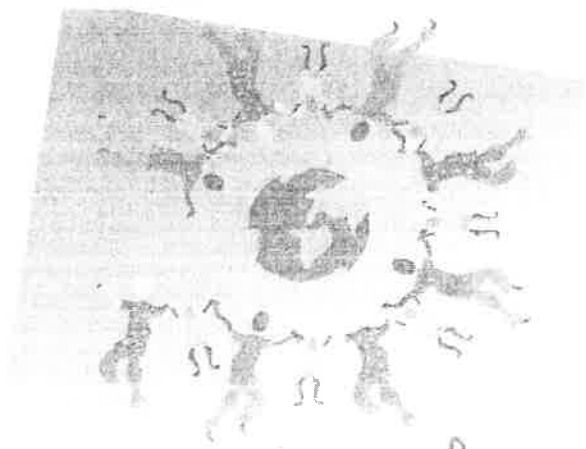

The Williamsburg County Emergency Management Division is still working with the Electrical Utility Company for restoration of electrical power to residences in Williamsburg County. We still have several residences without power. Due to the high temperatures and heat index, we are opening cooling shelters in the Hemingway and Greeleyville Area. We are opening Hemingway High School and C E Murray High School from 12:00 PM to 5:00 PM for residences that are without electrical power. These shelters are only for cooling purposes and will only provide water for the citizens that are sheltered. If there are any residences that are still without electrical power to your homes from the storm the shelters are opened. Our mission is to protect property, save lives and relieve human suffering.

Florence County opens Cooling Centers for residents needing relief

FLORENCE, S.C. - Due to the high heat index Monday and the large number of Florence County citizens without electrical power, two Cooling Centers have been opened within the county.

The Cooling Centers are located at the Windy Hill Fire Department (Station # 4) at 5610 E. Palmetto Street in Florence and the Pentecostal Holiness Church Family Life Center at 608 S. Ron McNair Blvd in Lake City.

These Cooling Centers are staffed by American Red Cross volunteers and will be open until 8:00 PM today.

Residents who are without electrical power are encouraged to seek refuge from the heat at these centers.
