### **SECTION 3: Supplemental (Non-Vacancy Specific) Recruitment Activities Undertaken**

Time Period Covered: **December 1<sup>st</sup> 2014 to November 30, 2015**

Station in Employment Unit: **WRIW**

1. **On-Going Internship Program** – This on-going internship program has been in place at the station for many years. The station welcomes students from area universities and colleges who are motivated about expanding their knowledge and hands-on experience in a broadcasting environment. They must be enrolled in a program related to the broadcasting industry, and their internship must be endorsed, supported, and constantly monitored by the sponsoring university. Upon completion of the semester-long program, students are rewarded with course credit hours. The internship periods include the Fall, Spring, and Summer semesters of each year. During the period covered by this report, WRIW had 2 interns work in the Sales and Marketing Departments.
2. **Massachusetts Broadcasters Association (MBA) Job Fair** – WRIW sponsored the MBA Job Fair on April 22, 2015. Yesenia Peguero represented the station with a booth at the event and she also had the opportunity to meet with students about internship opportunities with WRIW Providence. She distributed information about the internship programs at the stations and collected resume from potential job seekers. The MBA works to promote careers in broadcasting as exciting and fulfilling career choices. Via job fairs, Equal Employment Opportunity webinars, the MBA works together with broadcasters throughout Massachusetts and surrounding states to disseminate job postings and applicant resumes to the public. The MBA office also maintains an online database of resumes to aid stations in filling their open positions. WRIW collaborates closely with the organization to contribute to its mission, promote opportunities as well as participate in continued training and development.
3. **Ocean State Business Expo**

WRIW sponsored the 2015 Ocean State Business Expo. The event highlights local experts from our business community, information presentations and a place to build connections. Bringing the best business professionals in Rhode Island together! Services and products from the expert exhibitors are available throughout the day.
