Coronavirus / Pandemic

Wildfire preparation

- April 9 – Broadcast Zoom event hosted by Yubanet - “The Small Outdoors” - focusing on getting ready for fire season, including gardening tips and outdoor fire safety practices
- May 21 – Broadcast virtual town hall hosted by Yubanet - “Preparing for wildfire in western Nevada County”.
- June 26 – Interview with Mark Bottron, fire chief for Grass Valley & Nevada City – regarding fire safety and extra precautions to take as we enter the height of fire season
- Worked in conjunction with Nevada County Office of Emergency Services to disseminate information regarding property cleanup, green waste disposal, defensible space, and fuel mitigation programs throughout the foothills.
- Disseminate information on numerous escaped debris burns and small fires throughout the foothills with emphasis on prevention and defensible space

Additional significant community issues

- Water news - a weekly news report with hydrologist Steve Baker of Operation Unite, covering topics related to water quality and management with a focus on water topics specific to the KVMR listening area.
- Honoring area residents - KVMR’s weekly program “The Sages Among US” features in-depth interviews with community residents ranging from philanthropists to elected officials to founders of charitable organizations who have made a significant positive impact on the community.
- Garden Forum, Homestead Radio Hour, and Organic Matters – programs focusing on gardening and farming issues specific to the foothills and how the pandemic has caused an increased interest in raising your own food.
