One of the most noticeable -- gas prices, especially diesel gas. As of Thursday, the AAA website shows the average price for diesel across Florida is \$5.63 per gallon. Pensacola Economist Dr. Rick Harper says the price for diesel is up about 10% from what we saw a few weeks ago. Dr. Harper says we were predicting the price for gas and diesel would hit record highs this summer before Russia invaded Ukraine. As the country recovers from the COVID-19 pandemic, more people are trying to get out and travel. Bringing the demand for diesel and gas higher.

Many people were in Downtown Pensacola Friday afternoon for a rally protesting the reversal of Roe v. Wade. Those who attended the rally were concerned by what the court may do next.
