

PRE-FILING AND POST-FILING RENEWAL ANNOUNCEMENT
INSTRUCTIONS

The following three pages contain instructions for the broadcast of the pre-filing and post-filing renewal announcements for Sinclair's Norfolk station. Included with these instructions are the texts of the two types of announcements and a Statement Certifying Compliance that needs to be completed, dated, executed and placed in the station's public inspection file within seven (7) days after the last post-filing renewal announcement has been aired or by **August 23, 2012**. If for any reason the station did not air the required announcement on the specified days and during the specified time periods, please contact the company's communications counsel before the Statement Certifying Compliance is finalized, dated and executed.

Pre-filing Renewal Announcements for
WTVZ-TV, Norfolk, Virginia, FAC ID 40759

The following pre-filing renewal announcement must be read over the air on each of the following days: April 1, April 16, May 1 and May 16, 2012. Of the four airings, at least two of these announcements must be broadcast between 7:00 A.M. and 9:00 A.M. and/or between 4:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M.

Text:

"On April 18, 2006, WTVZ-TV was granted a license by the Federal Communications Commission to serve the public interest as a public trustee until October 1, 2012.

Our license will expire on October 1, 2012. We must file an application for license renewal with the FCC by June 1, 2012. When filed, a copy of this application will be available for inspection during regular business hours. It contains information concerning the station's performance over the last eight years.

Individuals who wish to advise the FCC of facts relating to our renewal application, and to whether this station has operated in the public interest, should file comments and petitions with the FCC by September 4, 2012.
