ISSUES COVERED INCLUDE: FAMILY RELATIONSHIPS, RACE RELATIONS, WOMEN'S ISSUES, HEALTH, COMMUNITY VENTURES, AND CO-OPS; TEENAGE ISSUES; AS WELL AS FINANCISAL ADVICE, ADULT EDUCATION, SUBSTANCE ABUSE – PREVENTION – RECOVERY; SOUP KITCHENS, HOMELESS MINISTRIES, AND HELP FOR IMPOVERISHED PEOPLE. I'M SURE THAT THERE ARE MANY OTHER CATEGORIES I HAVE FAILED TO MENTION, AS ON CERTAIN OCCASIONS, THE HOST WILL SELECT A SPECIFIC THEME FOR THAT NIGHT.
