Monday & Tuesday: The issue on these broadcast was “The Right of the Unborn.” The pro-life movement is not often followed or reported on by the mainstream press. Focus on the Family radio broadcast maintains an office that provides spokes people who answer questions and supply information about the movement. Abby Johnson was the guest, and the host was Anissa Porticelli.

Wednesday & Thursday: The issue on these two broadcasts was information about a grassroots movement based in Texas that seeks to provide as much information about political office candidates across the country as possible. I-Voter Guide uses the Internet to collect and display issue position statements for candidates for federal office and is gradually working down closer and closer to community candidates. The guest was founder Debbie Wuthrow, and the host was Paul Kretschmer.

Friday: The issue on this broadcast was surviving abortion and becoming a pro-life advocate. The guest was Melissa Ohden, speaker at a Family Institute of Connecticut function in 2021. She survived a saline abortion attempt and was born without medical or physical harm. She uses her birth experience and life since then to advocate for the protection of all unborn children from conception to birth. The host was Paul Kretschmer.

Saturday: The issue of this broadcast was obtaining Christian faith centered financial advice and help in managing finances. The guest was Steve Bibisi from Kingdom Financial Solutions. He explained how a client comes to his office, the challenges they may face and the common sense action those clients can take to get their money situation under control and live debt free in the future.
