Monday: The issue on this program was an organization that seeks to return Connecticut to the values that worked for the people of the station for many years in the past and could bring revival in the state in the present and future. Legacy Coalition is the organization that brings people together. Larry Fowler was the guest, and the host was Anissa Porticelli.

Tuesday: The issue on this program was Christian music and an appearance by a trio of siblings called "Cain." Christian music is less common day in and out than in some other parts of the country. An effort is made by Jacob's Well in Vernon, CT to bring musicians to the area. The guests were Taylor, Madison & Logan Cain, and the host was Steve Tuzeneu.

Wednesday & Thursday: The issue on this program was a long running court case focusing on equity in education for all people, regardless of ethnicity known as "Sheff versus O'Neill." The court case, after 30 years, appears to be coming to a conclusion. Guests on this program was Elizabeth Sheff, who filed the suit in court, and Attorney General William Tong, representing the state.

Friday: The issue on this program was bringing to Danbury, Connecticut a newer form of radiation therapy for the treatment of cancers called "Proton Therapy." Northwestern Connecticut has not had ready access to this therapy till now and Danbury Hospital is the new location for it. The guest was spokesman Drew Crandall, and the host was Steve Tuzeneu.

Saturday: The issue on this program was a possible freeze on levying a 25 cent state gas tax on motor vehicle gasoline between April 1 and June 30, 2022. Governor Ned Lamont hosted a news conference, explained what he intended to do and took questions. The freeze is intended to provide some savings at a time of high fuel costs due to current inflation and the war between Russia and Ukraine. The host was Paul Kretschmer.
