If you receive counterfeit money, please call 911 to report the incident.  The Federal Reserve provides resources and quick reference guides for identifying counterfeit bills.  Businesses may want to review these with employees.

The money will go towards a flood protection system for a Waste Water Plant, located along Lake Taneycomo, which is at extreme risk of flood damage.  The state has forty-one million dollars in grant money to distribute, and is seeking public comment on how the money should be spent.
