2. **News** (Branson Today) Is a "softer" news program that covers primarily local topics of interest to Branson area residents and some topics of interest to visitors. One of the main areas of interest is information regarding community charity fund raising events, as well as current events, such as ground breakings and ribbon cuttings in the community. It is generally a preview of what will be happening in the Branson area either on that day, or in a few days to come. Newslines do not report on violent crime, but does give tips and suggestions from local authorities on crime prevention and awareness. Newslines also include a daily local weather forecast. This program airs a minimum of 5 times per day, 7 days a week.
