Tri States Public Radio (TSPR) carries 57 hours each week of NPR programming, of these programs 46 hours are news programs. Throughout the week a total of 30 NPR newscasts can be heard. TSPR also carries 43 hours of BBC programming, all of which is news oriented. TSPR broadcasts 116.5 minutes of local news during Morning Edition and in afternoon newsbreaks each week. News programs from distributors other than NPR and BBC equal 9 hours each week and include programming that focuses on Illinois State Politics, Women's Issues, national business and Latino community in the US. The remainder of our programming is a mix of music (Classical, Folk/Americana and Jazz) and infotainment programming.
