SYNOPSIS: Topics discussed on today's program:

- The Affordable Care Act rollout continues to fail.
- The healthcare registration website is unable to handle the high traffic from mass registration.
- The website was found to be woefully lacking in security measures to protect the private information of registering citizens. It has been reported to be easier to hack than other similar registration websites dealing with less sensitive information.
- False websites can easily be created to mimic the ACA registration site.
- Controversy over the contract to design the website continues to grow. The contract was not bid on by competing companies but was granted by the Government to CGI. CGI has a history of repeated failures, having lost a \$46 million contract after missing three years of deadlines and falling fourteen months behind schedule and failed to design a similar but smaller database in Ontario. The project has already cost tax payers \$600 million and is said to need to be started over.

• States setting up their own healthcare exchanges have met with more success than the federal system.
