Then, Senate Democrats looking to take control. Fernando discusses their strategy with Seung Min Kim, Congressional Reporter for POLITICO. It's a conversation about party "brands" and whether voters can differentiate between individual candidates and those at the top of the tickets.

Huerta, known to many as the co-founder of the United Farm Workers (UFW) with Cesar Chavez, discusses the Presidential campaign, her vigorous support for Hillary Clinton, and her concerns that Trump's candidacy could pose a serious threat to our democracy.

Can we give comfort to Orlando? Moving images capture acts of kindness, moments of compassion, and quiet efforts to comfort those whose lives have been devastated by the shooting rampage in Orlando.

Finally, Fernando Espuelas challenges Congressional leaders over their role in enabling the Orlando killer to legally buy weapons. His commentary addresses the question: how can a person twice investigated for possible connections to terrorists legally purchase semi-automatic weapons? What needs to happen to prevent a repeat tragedy?
