High School students spend time at job sites to learn more about various jobs and career opportunities. Students usually spend three to four hours a day for two to six weeks at WKYT, usually in the news department or the production department shadowing and observing the various jobs in each department. During the reporting period, 1 EBCE student participated at WKYT as follows: From October 30, 2017 through December 20, 2017, 1 student from Paul Laurence Dunbar High School participated in the News department.

2	Job Fairs	WKYT participated in the following job/career fairs during the reporting period: 1. Morehead State University on October 3, 2017, where more than 380 students and alumni attended and 40 businesses organizations were set up at the fair. Representing Gray Television were the VP – Operations Manager, along with a News Anchor and the Chief Meteorologist from WKYT-TV, as well as Sales Managers from WYMT-TV. 2. Western Kentucky University on February 28, 2018. Approximately 400 students and alumni attended the job fair which had 98 employers on site. Representing Gray Television were the Human Resources Manager and the News Director at WBKO-TV.
3	Management EEO training	On March 28, 2018, WKYT's General Manager presented information to the WKYT Senior Management team regarding correct EEO procedures for job postings.
