Students usually spend three to four hours a day for two to six weeks at WKYT, usually in the news department or the production department shadowing and observing the various jobs in each department. During the reporting period, 4 EBCE students participated at WKYT as follows: In the Spring of 2013, 1 student participated in the news department and 1 student participated in the sales department. In the Winter of 2014, 2 students participated the in news department.

2	Job Fairs	WKYT participated in the following job/career fairs during the reporting period: 1. Morehead State University on 10/1/13, where more than 250 students and alumni attended. Representing Gray Television were the Office Manager, A Senior News Reporter, and the Assistant Engineering Supervisor from WYMT. 2. Western Kentucky University on 10/23/13 – approximately 400 students and alumni attended. Representing Gray Television were the Human Resources Manager and the News Director at WBKO-TV. 3. Western Kentucky University on 3/19/14 – approximately 430 students and alumni attended. Representing Gray Television were the Business and Human Resources Manager, News Director, and Sales Manager at WBKO-TV. 4. 4	Internship program	WKYT offers internships with several different universities. During the reporting period, 17 interns participated at WKYT as follows:
		1. In the Spring of 2013, 5 students participated in the news, sports, promotion, and sales/marketing departments. Two of these students were attending the University of Kentucky, and 1 each from Morehead University, Western Kentucky University, and Eastern Kentucky University.
		2. In the Winter of 2013, 4 students participated in the News and Promotions departments. One each from Eastern Kentucky University, University of Kentucky Community College, National College, and Grambling College.
		3. In the Summer of 2013, we had 1 student participate in the News department from the University of Kentucky.
		4. In the Fall of 2013 we had 4 students from the University of Kentucky participated in the Promotions, News, and Sports departments.
		5. During the Winter of 2014, 3 students took part in the internship program in the Sales, News, and Sports departments. One each from the University of Kentucky, Georgetown College, and National College. Interns at WKYT are supervised by the following station staff:
