ISSUES COVERED: Teddy Bear Den Annual Celebrity Night Out

GUEST(S) AND PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: Teresa Karl, a mom of a suicide victim, registered nurse and founder of the Be a Lifesaver organization discussed ways to approach or help someone who has expressed a desire to end their life. She also offered educational and informational resources that everyone can have access to online and also in schools.

ISSUES COVERED: Cure Kids Cancer Radiothon

Date: Thursday, March 31<sup>st</sup> and April 1st

Duration: 12 hours each day (6am-6pm)

GUEST(S) AND PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: Result Radio stations participated in the 9th Annual Cure Kids Cancer Radiothon, a collaboration between the Results Radio/Townsquare Media radio stations to raise funds to support children and families battling cancer with direct support in the form of meal, travel & lodging vouchers, also to purchase specialized equipment, fund the ChildLife and educational departments at Sanford Children's Hospital as well as support ongoing research for treatments and cures.
