The C.H. Mason health clinic recently relocated to their church – the Holy Redeemer of God in Christ Church. For now, it will offer basic services including blood pressure and cholesterol checks, HIV/STI testing, vaccines, and health education. They already have plans to expand. Having this clinic inside a church that so many in the community know and trust makes a difference. To have something like this in the north side of the community is giving greater access to many individuals who may not trust the system themselves.
