Cumulus Licensing LLC ("Cumulus") is the licensee of Stations WHRP(FM), Gurley, Alabama (Facility ID 22264) and WUMP(AM), Madison, Alabama (Facility ID 39590), which appeared on the list associated with the August 19, 2022, FCC Public Notice that identified stations randomly selected for an EEO audit. These Stations are part of a Huntsville, Alabama station employment unit ("SEU") with commonly-owned stations WVNN(AM), Athens, Alabama (Facility ID 3084), WVNN-FM, Trinity, Alabama (Facility ID 25385), WFFF-FM, New Market, Alabama (Facility ID 65223), and WZYP(FM), Athens, Alabama (Facility ID 3083).

Cumulus respectfully requests an extension of time to respond to the FCC's August 19, 2022 EEO Audit Letter ("Letter"). After having just completed the filing of numerous regulatory fees with many

problems with the updated CORES system while at the same time assisting on numerous annual EEO public file reports along with many other responsibilities, the timing of responding to the Letter by October 7, 2022 has become challenging. In addition, the client's employees are still working from home which delays gaining access to the materials needed for the response.

In order to assemble the documentation requested in the Letter and present a well-organized and thorough response, Cumulus respectfully requests a 45 day extension of time to complete its reply.
