F. Airing of Public Service Announcements - Each student is required to play or read a minimum of two PSA's per hour during his or her airshift. When there is no one manning the studio, the computer automation system plays music; for each hour there is a minimum of two to three public service announcement played per hour. KLPR plays PSA's in English and Spanish, and a variety of other languages when available. KLPR also airs PSA's that target certain demographic groups and ethnic groups, such as Native Americans, African Americans, and Asian Americans. The following PSA's were aired this period: Adoption, Al-Anon Family Groups, American Lung Association, Animal Society, ASPCA, Asthma Prevention, Bullying Prevention, Diabetes, Federal Student Aid, Folic Acid, Homeland Security, Living Healthy & Green, Macular Degeneration, Making Home Affordable, March of Dimes, NAMM—Music in Schools, Obesity Prevention, Peace Corp, Polio Elimination, Preserving Waterways, Radon, ROTARY, SCORE—small business assistance, Selective Service, Stroke Awareness, Sustaining Places, Take Me Fishing, Veterans' Crisis Line, Veterans' Services, Women's Pulmonary Health, Wounded Warrior Project.
