Employment Unit Outreach Efforts

The Employment Unit completed the following outreach activities during the reporting period covered by this report:

1. Event Sponsored by Educational Institution.

On-air personalities made 3 appearances to read to children at several different elementary schools as part of the Read Across America program, which took place in different schools mostly in the Erie School District. The event honors the anniversary of the birthday of Dr. Seuss.

One Multimedia Journalist acts as a mentor for Clarion University. He works with the University's Communication Department. Students reach out to him with any questions they may have about the broadcasting field, resumes, employment and more.

Meteorologist Reed McDonough, and Forecaster John Stehlin attended the Imagination Expo for children. They showed children how they use the green screen and graphics to show the weather. Kids at the event could pretend they were on television giving the weather forecast.

One Anchor was a guest reader at the Achievement Center. The Achievement Center is designed to meet the unique needs of children and adolescents who are experiencing emotional, physical, or behavioral challenges.
