Performance Initiatives Undertaken

During the reporting period, the Employment Unit conducted station tours with the following: Student from William Jessup University was welcomed in on November 13, 2019 for a station tour; student received a full facility tour and was given the opportunity to sit with employees from the KHKT programming department for advice and a Q&A on how to access careers in sports media or radio broadcasting. Student from Sierra College was welcomed in on January 14, 2020 for a station tour; student received a full facility tour and was given the opportunity to meet with station personnel from the Programming Department for a Q&A on careers in radio broadcasting and writing content for newspaper.

During the reporting period, one (1) student participated in the Employment Unit's job shadow program: Student from Cal Poly who was majoring in Events and Hospitality shadowed with a top performing Account Executive and the NTR & Events Director on August 7, 2019 from 8:30a – 5:30p. The job shadow opportunity enabled the student to observe and learn about many aspects of the radio station; including how to plan, coordinate and execute a large event. Student also learned how to package sponsorships for events and present to and sell event sponsorships to clients.

To promote understanding of, and compliance with, our policy of equal opportunity employment, all new employees hired have been required to complete two trainings, Sexual Harassment Prevention and Discrimination and Harassment Prevention, as part of their onboarding process. On July 15, 2020 the HR Business Partner attended a virtual seminar offered by California Chamber of Commerce, Putting Racial Justice Words into Action: Best Practices and Strategies for California Businesses.

The Employment Unit established and conducts a "Lunch & Learn" training program. The "Lunch & Learn" program is designed to enable sales and other employees to learn information and gain skills in marketing and selling practices necessary for advancement to higher level positions in the radio industry.

The Employment Unit participates in a company-wide mentorship program: This mentoring initiative pairs employees with a mentor to give employees (mentors and mentees) an opportunity to develop professional relationships, skills and attributes that will help them progress in their career development. This program is a six (6) month commitment and employees from all departments are encouraged to participate. Programs for this reporting period took place from June 2019 – December 2019 & February 2020 – July 2020

The Employment Unit participated in a company-wide workshop, Leading with the Speed of Trust: This program is designed to help our current leaders improve their skills by providing important tools, training and resources to take back and implement within their teams. Participants attended a 2-day workshop where they were challenged to develop an action plan to help promote trust within their individual teams and throughout the organization.
