Section A: Newscast Overview

KAOC FM Radio produces 4 daily newscasts. Three to Five minute 'morning drive' reports air at 6;30, 7:30, 8:30 and 9:03am.

News Treatments: The nominal length of each of our lead or feature stories described below is between thirty-seconds and two minutes-thirty seconds.

News Cycle: Exclusive stories run in each of the daily local newscasts before being archived. As an example: A local story or feature will air 4 times in the course of a day, once in each newscast. In addition these stories are available to our audience ondemand via our station website for one week from date of first broadcast.

Cavalier County Prepares For Major Event At High School

Law enforcement, emergency services and first responders from the surrounding area, and the public school system in Langdon will be busy responding today to a simulated incident involving an emergency event at the Langdon High School. The City and County first responders, along with school officials and teachers will be participating in the event which will be held after normal school hours.

The simulated emergency event will serve to assess the schools emergency preparedness plan, which includes Lockdown of the school during the exercise. A second objective includes assessing the response of law enforcement and other emergency services in the area.

An educational session for the teachers at the school will begin at 2:00 pm. The exercise will begin at approximately 4:30 pm. (Aired on September 24th)

5K Memorial For Minto Man

Gregory "Guy" Miller, 55, of Minto was swept away in the raging spring floodwaters on April 29 of 2013. His body was recovered September 7. To honor his memory and to raise money for a special cause, a 5K Run and Walk is taking place around rural Minto tomorrow morning. Miller's sister, Kelly Schanilec, says the proceeds from the 5K will be going to the Northeast Regional Water Operations Team who were called in to find Guy after he went missing in April.

Registration can be done online at www.guymillermemorial.com or from 3 to 7 p.m. tonight at the Minto Community Center. They will also accept registrations from 7 to 8 a.m. tomorrow morning. The race will start at approximately 9 a.m. tomorrow and the course will work itself to the countryside of Minto to the location where Miller was found.

There will also be door prizes and a silent auction when the racers cross the finish line.

Langdon Residents Without Water

Some Langdon residents will be without water today due to a malfunction of a valve on a main line that runs to the East water tower in town. The city will be working on the line starting at 8 a.m. and will continue working on it until the issue is corrected. Water Plant Supervisor Chad Mittleider says he hopes to have the water turned back on by sometime this afternoon.

He says affected areas are as follows: All areas South of the railroad tracks that are East of 7th Street. Areas North of the railroad tracks are 5th Street and 10th Avenue going South and 4th Street from 9th Avenue South. Fatal Accident in Rolla

A fatal accident occurred in Rolla yesterday involving a 6-year old girl. Ronald Mackinnon, 72, was driving westbound on US Highway 281 in the city limits of Rolla when the girl rode across the highway from the north. North Dakota Highway Patrol says that Mackinnon did not observe the bicyclist cross the roadway as he was checking his rear view mirror. Mackinnon was unable to avoid the bicyclist and struck her with the front end of the pickup. The girl was pronounced dead on scene. (Aired on August 20th)

Section B: Special and Non-Broadcast Events

Throughout the year Simmons Stations assist local groups and organizations with the promotion and or cosponsorship of various activities and events. Our involvement may include contributions of in-kind advertising, cash donations, company staff donating their own time to assist with a given event, etc. Below are some examples which are representative of these efforts.

1- Stars Air Ambulance Fundraiser

The STARS Air Ambulance Service makes more rescue flights into the Pembina Valley than anywhere else in the Manitoba Province with farm accidents accounting for the largest percentage of its calls. STARS receives minimal government funding and relies heavily on donations to provide their service. On September 12 Simmons Stations participated in a fundraising event which helped raise nearly \$200,000 to keep STARS flying. (Exhibit 1)

2 - Sports Guide

Simmons Multimedia produces a printed High School Sports Guide that features fall and winter sports. The advertiser supported guide is distributed free of charge throughout the listening area each season. A copy is attached. (Exhibit 2)

3- Marketing Seminars - Client Outreach

Simmons Multimedia Stations continue to provide free 'nuts and bolts' marketing education seminars to clients and non-clients alike. A typical seminar includes a power point presentation focusing on traditional and digital media. These workshops are facilitated by two representatives from the Simmons Multimedia Marketing Department. Seminars are conducted at the client's place of business or our conference room.
