#### March into Spring Contest



# Section – C – Newscast Overview

KAOC FM Radio produces 4 daily newscasts. Three to Five minute 'morning drive' reports air at 6:30, 7:30, 8:30 and 9:03am.

News Treatments: The nominal length of each of our lead or feature stories described below is between thirty-seconds and two minutes-thirty seconds.

News Cycle: Exclusive stories run in each of the daily local newscasts before being archived. As an example: A local story or feature will air 4 times in the course of a day, once in each newscast. In addition these stories are available to our audience on-demand via our station website for one week from date of first broadcast.

The attached stories are representative of the local news content we produce on a daily basis:

#### 010518 Langdon Structure Fire

Fire dominated Main Street in Langdon Thursday night. The Cavalier county Sheriff's office says a fire call came in about 8:30 PM, with the blaze involving the building housing the Langdon General Store. According to the Sheriff's office Langdon firefighters were assisted by the Munich Fire Department and the Cavalier Air Force Station. The fire was confined to the one building and was expected to burn through the night and into the day on Friday. Firefighters remained on site into the early morning hours.

#### 010518 Crews battle large fire in Hallock

Multiple crews responded to a large fire in Hallock, Minnesota Wednesday night. The Kittson County Sheriff's Department says just before 6:30 p.m. a neighbor noticed flames shooting from the roof of the Hallock Electric building.

#### 030718 Fatal snow plow crash on I-29

A Tuesday morning crash between a plow and a passenger vehicle caused the death of a Fargo man on Interstate 29 near Reynolds, N.D. The 35-year-old male driver was driving north at about 7:30 a.m. in the left passing lane of I-29. A Highway Patrol trooper had stopped "partially in the left lane" to investigate a different crash in the median of that section of road, less than 2 miles north of Reynolds. The trooper was accompanied by a tow plow from the Department of Transportation
