RADIO QUARTERLY ISSUES/PROGRAMS LISTING

Requirements: Sections 73.3526(e)(12) and 73.3527(e)(8) of the FCC's rules require that every three months each radio broadcast station prepare a listing of programs that have provided by the station to address and treat the most significant community issues during the preceding three month period. Retention requirement: The lists described in this paragraph shall be retained in the public inspection file *until final action* has been taken on the station's next license renewal application.
