



The program is a tax-funded attempt to develop future leaders among the existing population, with support from several local tax entities and foundations.

The county is about 60% Hispanic, and the public schools approach 80% Hispanic. Although much of the Latino population is bi-lingual, a large minority speaks and understands only Spanish. 


