ISSUES: KPAN AM-FM has identified a lack of awareness and community support for Hereford Preparatory Academy as an issue in Hereford. The newly-opened campus is still struggling to find its place and identity.

KPAN has identified a lack of a credible news source for the local Hispanic community as an ongoing issue facing Deaf Smith County. The county is about 60% Hispanic, and the public schools approach 80% Hispanic. Although much of the Latino population is bi-lingual, a large minority speaks and understands only Spanish. Their only source of local news is KPAN AM-FM.

PROGRAMS: KPAN AM-FM interviewed Rachel Ramirez of Hereford Preparatory Academy about its student leadership program at 8:45am July 9. Rachel Ramirez was also interviewed at 8:45am August 18 about enrollment and various student opportunities at HPA. Ashley Adcox of HPA was interviewed at 8:45am August 11 on an HPA summer event aimed at team-building among students and faculty. In addition, news coverage on HPA was broadcast on KPAN AM-FM July 13; August 11, 21, 27; September 2 and 17.

The content of the KPAN RadioGram is translated into Spanish by Josie Nava and broadcast weekdays at 6:30pm during the Spanish-language program. The KPAN RadioGram is published online 6 days a week and is posted to Facebook 6 days a week as well. It is published and distributed weekdays to 25 outlets in Hereford. It is the basis for 6 daily news report during English-language broadcasts on KPAN. A few copies from this quarter are attached.

WEATHER: (August 25, 2015) TUESDAY – High yesterday afternoon was 89 at 4:00; this morning's low was 62 at 7:00. KPANcast: Sunny and hot with a 20% chance of thunderstorms.

LOCAL: Hereford residents were notified by mail Monday that the municipal drinking water system collected two samples in July that contained coliform bacteria. The City of Hereford tests 15 samples a month, and samples from Baltimore Street and East 15<sup>th</sup> Street showed contamination. Two more samples were taken and re-tested and the results were negative for coliform bacteria. City manager Rick Hanna said the municipal water supply is safe and clean, and that he suspected the samples themselves had become contaminated before or during testing.......Hanna said if there would have been an imminent threat to public health, city officials would have immediately taken action to warn local residents.......U.S. stocks slumped again Monday and finished the day down 588 points, part of a global wave of selling triggered by economic slowdown in China. The chaos spilled over into the agriculture markets, with October live cattle off \$1.53 to \$142.32 a hundred, and October feeder cattle down \$4.57 a hundred........ Funeral mass for Robert Fuentes Sr., age 60, will be at 10:00 Thursday at San Jose Catholic Church. He was a lifelong resident who had operated R&R Machine and Welding with his son....... 

LOCAL: The weekend Pacific storm took a more southerly track than predicted, but still produced high wind and significant snow across the region. Blizzard conditions existed from late Saturday night through the day Sunday, with north wind to 62 mph and snow drifts 2 to 4 feet around Hereford.
