Quarterly Issues/Programs List

WNTM provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **Disabilities/Education:** Discussion of programs available at Goodwill Easter Seals of the Gulf Coast, including a daycare program for disabled adults, job training, and intervention programs for preschool children. iHeart Radio Gulf Coast announcer Ariel joined the program to talk about the help her child has received with speech therapy.

- **Disaster Preparedness:** Alabama Power Mobile Division spokeswoman talks about the utility's Hurricane Preparedness efforts and what the community can do to prepare for a storm, as well as tips for during and after (including safety with generators and watching out for downed power lines)
-
- **Drug Abuse Prevention:** Drug Education Council discusses report that drug overdoses are now the leading cause of death among Americans under 50. Julie Waters talks about losing her son to drugs.
-
- **Drug Abuse Rehabilitation:** Youth-Reach Gulf Coast program for young men 18-21 with drug/alcohol problems
-
- **Environment:** Mobile Baykeeper on upcoming fundraiser, the Grandman Triathlon, and new tools to let the public know the water quality in local bays, rivers etc.
- **Healthcare Assistance:** OZANAM CHARITABLE PHARMACY focuses primarily on maintenance medications for chronic illnesses - such as heart disease, diabetes and high blood pressure. Each year, over 1600 patients rely on Ozanam to get their medications so they don't have to choose between feeding their families and managing their illnesses. None of the patients pay for their medication, so Ozanam relies on support from the community to help fill their prescriptions.
- **Local Children's Projects:** Fuse Project Dragon Boat races at USS Alabama Battleship Memorial Park on June 10th. Encouraging teams to sign up to row and spectators to come out to the event to raise money for projects benefitting children in Mobile and Baldwin counties. (4th Annual Dragon Boat Festival raised over \$205,000). Two iHeart teams participated and the event was promoted on air and on the stations' websites.

- **Pet Health:** Veterinarian talks about pets and heartworms, and the connection with mosquitoes
- **Safety:** Distracted Driving- lawyer became an advocate to end distracted driving after daughter was killed
- **State politics:** Some of the major players in Governor Bentley's resignation discuss the process that led up to this and where we go from here.

- **Tourism:** David Clark of Visit Mobile talks about increased tourism numbers and future plans to grow tourism
- **Travel:** AAA spokesman talks about summer travel, gas prices, and safety on the roads
