WNTM provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **Disaster Relief:** Hurricane devastation in Texas and Florida, and how people can help through the Red Cross. iHeartRadio produced two 30 minute programs on hurricane relief after Hurricanes Harvey and Irma.
- **Locally, iHeartRadio Mobile/Pensacola joined with NBC 15 on Thursday August 31<sup>st</sup> from 6am to 6pm at two locations, in Mobile and in Daphne, Alabama, asking people to donate to the Hurricane Harvey Relief Fund of the Salvation Army. The effort was promoted across all local iHeart stations, as well as NBC 15, and raised over \$52,000.**
- 
- **Animal Rescue SPCA:** Pet overpopulation in Mobile County and how to prevent, through spaying/neutering, and local programs to place animals for adoption here and in other states through animal transport
- **Disabilities/Education:** Goodwill Easter Seals programs for disabled, job training, early childhood intervention
- **Economic Development:** Mobile Chamber's Business Expo; Business to business (B2B) marketing; Downtown Mobile Alliance on new projects in Mobile, including upscale apartments and revitalization of St Louis Street
- **Environment:** Nature Conservancy offering restoration jobs through GulfCorps and Restore Act; Changes in Recycling in Mobile make it easier for the public to recycle
- 
- **Hunger:** Feeding the Gulf Coast/ Chefs Challenge, a 3-state fundraiser on the Gulf Coast to support food bank programs, including the backpack program to give underprivileged school children food for the weekend.
- **Suicide Prevention:** Local event, Out of the Darkness Walk, to raise money for suicide awareness and prevention through the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention. Lydia Barber talks about losing her son to suicide. Conrad talks about help that is available for someone who is suicidal.
- **VOTING:** President of Alabama Policy Institute discusses how to choose who to vote for; Congressman Paul DeMarco of Alabama on Senate special

election; Mobile County Probate Judge Don Davis helps clarify the two elections happening back to back in our area, the special election for US Senate in Alabama and the Mobile municipal elections. He explains voting procedures, deadlines for registration, voter ID and other laws.
