Quarterly Issues/Programs List

WNTM provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC: The pandemic began during the First Quarter, but was quickly addressed by iHeartMEDIA both locally and nationally. On air talent gave listeners the latest information on how to protect themselves (masks, handwashing, social distancing), as well as sharing information on local closings, cancellations, and government health orders. That information was also shared on social media as well as the station website. iHeartMEDIA nationally began a PSA campaign on all stations, to share Coronavirus Facts and produced a weekly long form public affairs program Coronavirus Explained, to help share as much information as possible, including medical information, how to flatten the curve and why that was necessary, and relief organizations that were helping during the outbreak.

HEALTH: In addition to the pandemic, other health issues also affect listeners including cancer. iHeartMEDIA Mobile took part in the American Cancer Society Chili Cook-off to raise funds for support programs for local cancer patients. The issue of affordable healthcare for uninsured workers was also discussed, highlighting the work of Victory Health Partners, which provides general healthcare, specialty care and mental health care for nominal fees to working adults who are unable to afford insurance.

TOURISM: One of the biggest industries in South Alabama is tourism. Visit Mobile is promoting a new Destination Guide to help tourists find places of interest in our area, but it is also used by locals to explore areas they may not have seen and by workers at local attractions as a guide to suggest places tourists might have missed.

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT: Before the pandemic, with record low unemployment, businesses were having issues finding new employees. The Eastern Shore Chamber of Commerce hosted the Baldwin County Job and Career Expo to connect local businesses with those looking for a job or wanting to change careers. iHeartMEDIA Mobile took part in the Expo as a vendor and a media sponsor.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT: Fuse Project is bringing the Purpose Built Communities model to "The Avenue" neighborhood located in downtown Mobile. Fuse Project aims to make meaningful investments in mixed-income housing, cradle-to-college education and wellness to close the opportunity gaps that exist in the

community. iHeartMEDIA Mobile took part in a new event, the Lip Sync Challenge, to raise money for and spread awareness of the Historic Avenue Foundation.
