- **Education:** Susan G Komen fundraising events for Summer
- **Health:** Breast Cancer Research Center of Alabama
- **Disaster Relief:** Salvation Army efforts in catastrophe assistance
- **Tourism:** Dan Rowe with the Panama City Beach Convention and Visitors Bureau
