WNTM provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

Discussion in January, February and March on the Uncle Henry Show was dominated by the "sequester" budget fight in the Congress, the battle over gun rights and gun control, the city of Mobile's continuing financial problems, Mobile's new entertainment District, public corruption and local legislative elections.

In all three months, several shows were devoted to the control debate.

January 10th, Quin Hilyer of the American Spectator discussed the Steve Nodine public corruption/murder case, and then Steve Nodine appeared on the show February 19th and 20th to talk about his case.

January 15th, representatives from Hoimes For Our Troops were in studio to talk about their efforts to provide housing for disabled veterans.

January 21st, Nick Matranga, candidate for Alabama Senate District 35 came in studio to answer constituent questions.

January 24th, Alabama State Representative Jim Barton visited the show to talk about his campaign for State Senate District 35.

January 25th, Bill Hightower, candidate for State Senate District 35 came in studio to answer constituent questions.

January 28th, Dr Lou Campomenosi and Pete Riehm of the Common Sense Campaign citizens' group came on air to talk about the upcoming Alabama legislative session.

In February and March, Uncle Henry Show callers discussed efforts to ban tattoo parlors in several Baldwin County municipalities.

February 7, economist Dr Semoon Chang was in studio to discuss the impact of Mobile's recent sales tax increase.

February 8, Rob Holbert of Lagniappe, a local newspaper, talked on air about investigations into public corruption, and aan attempt to get better access to public records.

In February, there were several days of talk about the Carnival Cruise Ship Triumph, which docked in Mobile after experiencing engine trouble in the Gulf of Mexico.
