Quarterly Issues/Programs List

WNTM provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

Discussion in October, November and December on the Uncle Henry Show has been dominated by the Presidential election, Alabama politics, the city of Mobile's continuing financial problems, gun control and the end of daily newspaper publication in Mobile, Alabama.

In October, several shows were devoted to the Presidential and Vice-Presidential debates, with audio of the debates being played and discussed.

October 26, Kevin Wendt, VP of Content for Alabama Media Group, was a guest on the show to discuss the end of daily newspapers in Mobile, and the rise of digital news. Several shows in the quarter featured the topic of news gathering and distribution due to the Press-Register's decision to drop their printing schedule to three times a week.

October 29, former Press-Register columnist Kathy Jumper came on the air to discuss her transition from print media to digital.

October 30, Bill Armistead, the Chairman of the Alabama Republican Party appeared on the show to discuss the upcoming state and national election.

November 2, four guests from the Mobile and Baldwin County Young Republicans came in studio to discuss the upcoming election.

November 5, candidate for Alabama Chief Justice, Roy Moore, appeared on the show to talk about his election.

November 7, Senator Jeff Sessions came on the air to talk about the results of the Presidential election.

November 8, psychologist Patricia Vanderpool visited to offer suggestions on how people could deal with the negative emotions caused by the election.

From December 17 onward, talk show callers discussed gun control in the wake of the Sandy Hook School tragedy.

August 10th, New York City Firefighters Kirk Lester and Jim Lanza came into the WNTM studio to talk about the Tunnel To Towers Run, a charitable event held September 11th to raise money for local veterans' charities.

August 10 also saw a return visit from K Carl Smith of the Frederick Douglass Republicans to talk about minority participation in Republican politics.

August 28th local delegate Greg Callahan called from Tampa to discuss his involvement in the Republican National Convention.

September 11, Quin Hillyer, a Senior Fellow at the Center for Individual Freedom, talked about the Alabama Constitutional Amendment vote.

Sept 17, Dr Lou Campomenosi and Linda English of the Common Sense Campaign came on air to talk about the statewide vote.

September 18, four representatives of the Mobile County Young Republicans talked about Presidential politics.
