Quarterly Issues/Programs List

WNTM provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- **Disabilities/Education:** Scott Parks, the executive director for Project Outreach Gulf Coast... and two members of Project Outreach at their high schools, Sarah Reier at Spanish Fort and Courtney Cooner from Saraland talk about the program, which focuses on helping students with disabilities and their typical peers come together for the better of them both. Project Outreach is promoting local "Shooting for Change" basketball events for Autism awareness.
- **Drug Abuse and Prevention:** Drug Education Council director Virginia Guy talks about the local impact of the nationwide opioid crisis, how to recognize a drug problem in your family and how the Drug Education Council can help you find the resources you need. The Council has educational programs in local schools, to prevent drug abuse.
- **Economy:** Casey Williams, Christina Hellmich and Denise Curtis of the Eastern Shore Chamber of Commerce talk about the upcoming Baldwin County Career & Job Fair. iHeart Mobile/Pensacola is media sponsor of the Job Fair. The Fair features local employers in industries such as hospitality, aerospace, law enforcement, financial services, plus seminars for job seekers.
- **Environment:** Casi Calloway and Laura Stone from Mobile Baykeeper talk about coal ash... what it is, where it's located at Alabama Power's Barry Steam plant on the Mobile River, and how it could affect Mobile waterways and local environment if there was a breach of the containment system and tons of coal ash got into the Mobile River.
- **Healthcare Assistance:** Alabama Kidney Foundation is the only state-based organization in Alabama that provides direct services to kidney patients through financial assistance, education and support services. The Mobile Kidney Walk is the Foundation's premier fundraising event, dedicated to raising funds to help local kidney patients. iHeart Mobile/Pensacola formed a team for the Walk in honor and memory of a co-worker who just died.
- **Healthcare Assistance:** The American Cancer Society in Mobile, on plans for 30th annual Chili Cookoff. iHeart Mobile/Pensacola is radio sponsor for the event, as well as one of the teams cooking chili. The event is one of the biggest local fundraiser for ACS, with proceeds benefitting local programs such as Road To Recovery providing rides to treatment, Look Better Feel Better providing free wigs, and local support

groups.

- **Military:** Lt David Carter talks about plans for Navy Week in Mobile. The US Navy Band will participate in Mobile Mardi Gras parades, there will be a Navy ship in port for Mardi Gras, a Navy dive tank and explosive ordnance demonstrations, as well as local Navy personnel talking with students and a Navy representative meeting with local civic organizations, businesses and community groups.
- **Public Health:** Mark Bryant with the Mobile County Health Department talks about protecting yourself from the flu, especially with large public events like Mardi Gras coming up. And is there still time to get a flu shot?
- **Public Safety:** Mobile Fire Chief Mark Sealy and public information officer Stephen Millhouse talk about the Mobile Fire-Rescue Department achieving a new milestone in its ISO rating.
