# WNTM Quarterly Issues/Programs List

WNTM provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

• American Cancer Society: American Cancer Society's Road To Recovery program ensures that patients have access to transportation to their treatments if needed. The program is seeking volunteers to become drivers, to make sure patients can get to their doctor's appointments and treatment. They're also working on grants to pay for rides when volunteers are not available.

•

- Animal Rescue: Animal Rescue Foundation (ARF) is a local adoption agency, promoting spay and neuter, and helping find homes for strays and abandoned animals. Discussed the process for adoption, fostering, and volunteers.
- Children and Families: Ronald McDonald House provides a home away from home for families of children in the hospital
- Community Redevelopment: Fuse Project Dragon Boat Festival pits community and corporate teams against each other, racing 46 foot long dragon boats at the USS Alabama Battleship Park. Funds raised are used to support local children's projects. This year's focus is a new effort called Purpose Built Community, a community redevelopment project to help improve an area of Mobile in health, education, and economically. iHeart Radio Mobile/Pensacola/Biloxi participated in the races, with a team of 21 employees/family members. The event raised over \$250,000 toward this year's project.
- Drug Rehab, Corrections: The PASCO Home is a rehabilitation facility, and their Mission is to provide a Christian environment for men recovering from their addictions so that they might return to society to live a life free from chemical dependency. The show focused also on a new women's facility that is opening.
- Education: Signature Academies program of the Mobile County Public School System... giving high school students a real life look at various occupations. Each high school has its own signature academies. LeFlore High is adding a new Public Safety academy for police and fire fighters, which Mobile Police and Fire-Rescue hope will help them add diversity to their recruitment

- Environment: Mobile Baykeeper talks about Grandman Triathlon fundraiser; SWIM app to let you know the water testing results of the body of water where you swim; state vs local water quality testing for bacteria; and efforts to keep coal ash from a local power plant (Barry Steam Plant) out of local waterways. ALSO, interview on Alabama Coastal Foundation's Mission to improve and protect Alabama's coastal environment through cooperation, education, and participation. One example is their Oyster Shell Recycling Program. They pick up shells from local restaurants and put them back into the water to form reefs to grow new oysters, as opposed to the shells being hauled to a landfill.
- Severe Weather Preparedness: Alabama Power representative talks about preparations for hurricane season, to make sure they can restore power as soon as possible after a storm. She also talked about what customers can do to lessen the power burden; when you need to report an outage; the priorities for restoring power; and safe use of a generator. Also covered basic hurricane preparations, including food, water, batteries, radio, etc.
- Youthful Offenders: Mobile County Juvenile Court judge Edmund Naman discusses the NEST (Nurture, Equip, Strengthen, Transform) program he developed to help mentor young people who wind up in juvenile court, to get them back on the right track. Teams help youth achieve academic, employment and personal goals. Teams also help families with employment, budgeting, meal planning, housing and more.
