## WNTM Quarterly Issues/Programs List

WNTM provides its listeners with programming and public service announcements that address issues of concern to our local community. Among the issues determined to be of most concern to the community during the preceding calendar quarter were:

- Addiction, Veterans: The program with Virginia Guy of the Drug Education Council focused on the opioid epidemic, as well as other drugs and alcohol addiction problems on the Gulf Coast, particularly with veterans. John Kilpatrick talked about plans for residential and outpatient treatment facilities in Mobile through the nonprofit Veterans Recovery Resources, which will work in conjunction with the Veterans Administration to get help to veterans.
- Children's Health: iHeartMedia has teamed up with Children's Miracle Network Hospitals to kick off the organization's Children's Hospitals Week in support of over 171 local hospitals across the country and highlights personal patient and family stories related to local hospital treatment. Please note that all donations made through this program will stay within the local community.
- Disabilities/Education: Exceptional Foundation, providing social/recreational activities for mentally challenged adults.
- Disabilities/Education: Keri Harmeir from the Exceptional Foundation of the Gulf Coast and Pastor Mike Hall of Dayspring Baptist Church, talk about local churches putting on Night to Shine Tim Tebow prom for those with special needs, who may have missed out on a prom opportunity in school. The free event is put on by over 500 churches nationwide, including churches in Mobile, Daphne and Pensacola
- Employment/Workforce Development: Baldwin County Career and Job Fair at the Daphne Civic Center brings together local employers and those needing jobs, while also providing free seminars for

job-seekers. Over 50 businesses, including iHeart Radio (a sponsor of the Job Fair) took part in the event. Also discussed, the overall employment and workforce development situation on the Eastern Shore and in Baldwin County.

- Environment: The city of Mobile, Mobile Baykeeper, and local businesses join forces to promote a Litter Free Mardi Gras. The goal is to educate citizens about what happens to the trash left on the streets during parades and parties, and encourage them to pick up around them, to keep litter out of local waterways.
- **Health:** Dr Landon Westfall from Southern Research in Birmingham talks about the flu outbreak across the country how to treat and prevent the flu.
- Housing: Eric Jefferson with Housing First talks about Project Homeless Connect, connecting homeless in Mobile and Baldwin Counties with local services, including medical, legal and employment. The group also conducts a Homeless Count, which helps HUD determine funding for local services.
