

## **CONTINUED ELIGIBILITY**

Section (f) (2) (A) of the Community Broadcasters Protection Act (“CBPA”) and Section 73.6001 of the Commission’s rules set forth the continuing eligibility Requirements for Class A licensees.

To maintain its eligibility for Class A license, a Class A station must continue to broadcast 18 hours a day, and must broadcast an average of at least 3 hours per week of locally produced programming as defined in 47 C. F. R. 73.6000.

WBXI-CD Television meets each of the continuing eligibility requirements. WBXI-CD broadcast 24 hours a day, 7 days a week during this time period – well over the 18 hours per day required.

### **January 1 through March 31 2019:**

Seven days a week WBXI presents StartTV. Start TV showcases strong and resourceful female leading characters in a lineup of contemporary and proven procedural dramas. Each lead character and series embody a boldness and determination to “Start” leading the way, seeking the truth, solving the crime and defending the innocent. Shows include Touched by an Angel, Dr. Quinn, Medium, among others. On Sunday mornings StartTV airs three hours of Children’s (E/I) programs.

Further, during 1st quarter 2019 and WBXI-CD produced and aired 5 hours per week (one hour Monday through Friday) of locally produced weather information pertaining to Indianapolis and central Indiana. In addition, WBXI aired 11 PSAs embedded in the Weather broadcast. Eight were locally produced (Drug Free Marion County, Keep Indianapolis Beautiful, Its My City, Indianapolis “Free Books”, and Indianapolis Cultural Trail) and all dealing with local issues and family concerns as shown in chart below:
