Rutgers Fact Sheet FS 1233, Growing Garlic in the Home Garden, recommends planting garlic in New Jersey in October, which means it's time to order them now for a June or July 2022 harvest. Garlic likes a site location with full sun and good soil drainage with light, well-drained soil. And a pH of 6.5 – 7.0 is ideal. You can send your soil sample to the Rutgers Soil Testing Lab for pH and nutrient recommendations, or contact Rutgers Cooperative Extension in Cumberland County for options to measure soil pH. Agriculture	Hello from the Rutgers Cooperative Extension Center of Cumberland County. This is Sal Mangiafico with What's Growing On.  Velvetleaf is an annual herbaceous plant, Abutilon theophrasti. It was introduced in the US in the 1700s from Asia as a potential source of fiber.  This may have seemed like a good idea at the time. However, it has become a leading weed problem in corn, soybeans, and other cultivated crops. It does has large velvety leaves, and a unique pie-shaped seed capsule. Each plant can produce 700 to 17,000 viable seeds, which can remain viable in soil for over 50 years. It typically occurs where the soil has been recently disturbed and the long dormant seeds have been brought close to the soil surface. It can grow two to four feet tall.
