Dear Ms. Pfannenstiel:

Pursuant to Section 614 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Section 76.64(f) of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission, this will inform you that for the period from January 1, 2009, to December 31, 2011, Television Station WMAK-DT, Knoxville, Tennessee, elects mandatory carriage of its television signal pursuant to Section 76.56(b) on your cable system serving **Alcoa, Black Mountain, Blount Co., Cobbly Knob, Corbin, Crossville, Farragut, Flat Lick, Friendsville, Gatlinburg, Knox Co., Kodak, Lenoir City, Lily, Loudon, Loudon Co., Louisville, Madisonville, Manchester, Maryville, Middlesboro, Monroe Co., Morgan Co., Pigeon Forge, Pine Mountain, Pitman Center, Roane Co., Rogersville, Sevier Co., Sevierville, Seymour, Sneedville, Stearns, Sweetwater, Tellico Village, Ten Mile, Wallins, Whitley City, and Williamsburg** in the Knoxville, Tennessee Designated Market Area ("DMA"). Station WMAK is licensed to Knoxville, Tennessee, which is within the Knoxville DMA. Station WMAK-DT therefore is entitled to elect mandatory carriage on your system.

Station WMAK-DT is entitled to positioning on cable channel **7**, which is the station's off-air broadcast channel.
