This to notify you, pursuant to Sections 76.64(f)(2) and (h) of the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Communications Commission that Pentecostal Revival Association, Inc., licensee of CLASS A television station WJGV-CD, Palatka, Florida, elects to exercise all rights to which it is entitled under the mandatory carriage provisions of Sections 75.56(b)(3) and 76.62 of the FCC's rules on your cable television system serving, Putnam and Alachua Counties, FL, including, but not limited to, the communities of Bostwick, Palatka, and Hawthorne, FL (the "Cable Communities"). This election is made for the period January 1, 2012, through December 31, 2014.

WJGV-CD is a qualified CLASS A television station, and therefore is entitled to carriage on your cable system serving the Cable Communities, as it satisfies the six-part test in Section 76.55(d) of the FCC's Rules:

1. WJGV-CD broadcasts 24 hours or more every day of the week and so meets the minimum operating requirements for full power stations set forth in Section 73.1740(a)(2)(ii) of the FCC's Rules (at least two hours each day and 28 hours per week).

2. WJGV-CD meets all obligations and requirements applicable to full power television stations with respect to the broadcast of nonentertainment programming and rates involving political candidates, election issues, controversial issues of public importance, editorials, and personal attacks; programming for children; and equal employment opportunity. 


