Before confronting someone, do it in love. Anger happens quickly. Waite till the anger leaves. Address the issue. Together put the problem out front and don't attack each other. This may take more than one meeting. Confrontation is everywhere. Look at it from their point of view. Make sure you cover everything completely. Discuss how to correct the situation. Use the sandwich method - Praise, deal with issue and praise. Never do it in an accusing manner. If you have intense feelings, let the other person know. Pray about it first. Calm down, relax and let god teach you how to approach it. The Holy Spirit is your teacher and guide. Ask what does that person need. If you feel violated, identify what it is that makes you feel that way. Give examples, but be careful how you tell them. Be open to their input. What is the goal of this confrontation? Try to come to a better place and resolution. Give the other person time to respond. Start out with statements like, "This is what I heard you say. Is that what you meant? What did I miss?" Kick it apart and resolve it. Be direct but tactful. Deliberately speak in a lower, slower soft voice. People need structures. Answer how to do it better next time. Make them feel that confrontation is good.</p>

This is an everlasting covenant. Below are critical events:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) 1917 – Balfour Declaration. A guarantee of British support against the Arabs where British forces moved into Palestine and took over for a Jewish State. This allowed for Jewish immigration for a few years. 2) 1937 – Arab Revolt organized in 1936. British government proclaimed land of Palestine be divided into an Arab state and a Jewish State. (Note: God promised Abraham from coast to coast this would be Israel with severe penalties for anyone who denounced His vow. This includes Ariel Sharon with a spiritual crime because of him giving away the land of Israel. 3) 1939 – The British White Paper was a reversal of taking the opposite position of the Balfour deal. Jews are not allowed to come in the land. Stopped immigration. November 29, 1947 Resolution 181 called for there to be an Israel and a Palestinian State. 4) May 14, 1948 – Fulfillment of prophecy and the rebirth of the State of Israel. <i>On the day in which the British Mandate over a Palestine expired, the Jewish People's Council gathered at the Tel Aviv Museum, and approved the following proclamation, declaring the</i>





It is a language that has an affect on person speaking and person hearing it. Psalms is the book of healing. Hebrew perceives itself as a healing language. It is a scientific fact that water molecules crystals form differently when certain sounds are initiated. Psycholinguistics, sociolinguistics, neurolinguistics are studies of how psychologically, socially, and neurologically language affects you. The origin of words in Hebrew is different than all other words. Gives you an internal look into why they use certain words. Examples: Write from right to left</p> <p>1st Letter of the Hebrew Alphabet is alef.</p>  <p>In English aloof means some one above, chrematistic of God. In Hebrew it means the master of the creation.</p> <p>2nd Letter is Bet, meaning home or house.</p> 

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				<p>AV - put together means olive bet (master of the home) Formal word for the father. Informal is abba - written</p>  <p>(but side by side N > N</p> <p>Mother "Mem" meaning water looks like</p>  <p>The master of prosperity and abundance.</p> <p>AM The smallest letter of the alphabet means infinite dot called "ud" and looks like a small 7. Put together with "Mem" means infinite water. Yam - sea or ocean.</p> <p>Understanding the conceptual basis of Hebrew is the first step, and you will be able to understand what God said.</p> <p>Let's look at some etymology of certain words: Salary - Time of Romans where they paid soldiers with salt, a valued commodity. Salt in Latin was Salarium. Today we receive salary in money, not in salt to buy valued commodities. Three letters are used for the root and if you know that in Hebrew, you can figure out any word even if you have never heard of it before. Formica - 17 century German Chemist was doing research with ants, and extracted a liquid. He called it formic acid. Formica in Latin is an ant. Later it was used in formaldehyde to preserve things, then in plastic industry, which came to lots of uses in the kitchen called Formica. Nylon - The company that invented it in 40's or 50's asked some one to come up with a name for the new material. He looked at the envelope requesting such, and said New York and London. So they named it nylon. NY/Lon. No meaning to what nylon really is. This just shows how all language is based on</p>
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				agreement but doesn't have an internal meaning. Hebrew has words based on concepts and project internal meaning.

Hebrew appeared 4000 years ago, and is probably more sophisticated than other languages. There is no documentation that it evolved from a primitive form. The Bible is the most advanced form of Hebrew. Hebrew was used to write the Bible. The Bible states it in the shortest way, and delivers the message with precision and flexible syntax. The sentence, "The king fell on his sword." In English you cannot change the sentence around without losing it's meaning, but in Hebrew you can. Hebrew was spoken by a small group of people. Hebrew mirrors the laws of nature. There are 22 letters that reflect a concept, and always remain with that idea. The root (3 letters) represents a root and gives the sum total of three ideas. Hebrew can link letters together. All words ever needed are embedded in this language. The term that could be interpreted as "computer" was mentioned in Genesis. When we are advanced enough technologically to need a word it is already there.
