Proverbs 18:24 tells us that we are to show ourselves as friendly. When teenagers and children get involved in crime and drugs and gang activity they always are asked. When did you start doing drugs or drinking alcohol or stealing cars? The answer is always the same in that they say a friend invited them or a friend gave it to them or they were along for the ride. It all comes down to communication. We should always think before we speak. We can have a truly altering of our lives if we simply read Proverbs and underline all the verses that spoke on thoughts and speech for one month. Why does this seem relevant to communication? When we are focused, God can speak to us easier. Proverbs 6:6 shows us that the wisdom of God will speak when we take the time to listen. God orders steps, not miles. We need to plan right and to think right.</p>

Genesis 1:14-20 tells us this as they were living in a pre-judgment time. The word of God names 3 different Heavens. From 1600 to 1800, Genesis 1:1 said that in the beginning, God created the Heaven and the Earth. In the 1700's, James Hutton founded the Uniformitarian's movement. After this time, Genesis 1:1 said that in the beginning, God created the Heavens, plural, and the Earth. There were 7 layers of the</p>

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				<p>atmosphere; the last one was water. 7 layers is the number of perfection. There are 6 layers now which is the number of man. Based on where fossils have been found it is necessary to understand that tropics and the ice age were in the same place. The lowest recorded temperature was -128.6 degrees below 0. The temperature would have had to be -300 degrees below 0 in order to preserve the animals in the way we have found them preserved. Some would say that the Woolly Mammoths had to be ice age animals because of their long hair. We have animals today such as the lion that have long hair as well. Long hair can insulate from heat as well. The question posed is this. If mammoths belong in the ice age, how did they get found in places like Texas, Florida and South America? Genesis 2 tells us that it didn't rain before the flood. Hebrews 11 tells us of things that were not seen. This was referencing Noah. Rain, up until this point, had not been seen. This is an even further testament of Noah's faith; to build an ark for no apparent reason whatsoever. The temperature in space is -459.6 degrees below 0. Genesis 8:22 tells us that seasonal changes did not occur pre-flood. This tells us that the temperature over all the earth stayed constant at one point and that animals could roam anywhere on the Earth. An interesting</p>
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				<p>fact about our poles: We have 2 North Poles and 2 South Poles. We have the North Pole and the magnetic North Pole and the same at the South Pole. This is significant because the pre-flood mechanism and the global mechanism will perpetuate itself. The direct poles are magnetic and conductive. Ice at extreme temperatures does not molecularly move. This is why it is attracted to the magnetic poles. When the Earth flooded, it flooded globally. People want to know the deeper truths. There are a lot of people with knowledge, but not the truth. The topic is truth or tradition: the influence of paganism on tradition. Jesus brought a sword of division. Man has his fingerprints all over the word of God. There are 38,000 denominations that are based on Christianity. 2Corinthians 11:14 says that Satan masquerades as an angel of light. When we are deceived, we don't know we are deceived. Barna Group is the world's number one Christian research. They stated, "The problem facing Christianity is not that people lack a complete set of beliefs. The problem is that they have a full slate of beliefs in mind, which they think are consistent with biblical teachings and they are neither open to being proven wrong nor to learning new insights. It may well be that spiritual evaluation is so uncommon because people fear a need to explore different growth strategies or more aggressive engagement in the growth process. No</p>

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				<p>matter what the underlying reason is, the bottom line among both clergy and lay people alike was indifference to their acknowledged lack of evaluation." John Calvin asked is it faith to understand nothing, and merely subject your convictions implicitly to the church?</p> <p>The plan of the enemy is to steal, kill and destroy. What is he trying to kill, steal and destroy? It is the truth. Abraham Lincoln said the best way to destroy your enemy is to make him you friend. From the enemy's perspective, we are the enemy and the only way to destroy us is to make us his friends and the only way he can do that is by coming as an angel of light. John F. Kennedy said that the great enemy of the truth is very often not a lie, deliberate, contrived and dishonest, but the myth, persistent, persuasive and unrealistic. Satan has no other plan, but to add to and take away from the word of God.</p> <p>The question posed is what are the most influential events in human history since the creation of time? The top 4 are firstly the giving of the commandments in the garden. Secondly, it is the giving of the commandments at Mount Sinai (blessings and curses). Third, would be the birth of the Messiah. Lastly, it is the death, burial and resurrection of the Messiah. If these are the top 4, what would you do as the enemy? You would steal, kill</p>
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				<p>and destroy. How have we established that he does that? Remember, he cannot change the truth, so the only thing he can do is add something to it, which is a lie.</p> <p>Many have never heard where we get Easter and Christmas from. The story of Easter goes back to Noah's great grandson, Nimrod. Nimrod was a mighty hunter in the land. He was king of the world at that time. He was known for his drunkenness, covetousness and strength. He built Nineveh and had great armies and had built the tower of Babel. As the first king of the Earth, upon his death the people deified him. He was the first person on Earth that the people on Earth deified. He was the sun god of the people and his name was Baal. Before he died, he married a woman named Semiramis. In the Babylonian legend, she gets pregnant by the rays of her deceased husband Baal and has a son named Tammuz. Tammuz is the resurrected Nimrod. He basically takes the place of his father. One day, while he is out hunting when he was 40 years old, he was killed by a wild boar. After that, the people deified him and called him the "son of god." Every year for 40 days, before the spring equinox, the people would fast. That's where we get Lent from. When Semiramis dies, she is deified as well. Her name becomes Ishtar or Astor. In English, it's called Easter.</p>
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				<p>She is the bare breasted fertility goddess of the East. Her husband is the god of the West and she is the god of the East: the sunrise and the sunset. Every spring equinox, the first Sunday after the spring equinox, the people would have Ishtar's Sunday. There would be a sunrise service. They would impregnate virgins on the altar. A year later, they would take the then 3 month old babies and sacrifice them and take the blood of the infants and die eggs into the blood. The eggs were, in ancient times, symbols of incredible fertility. They even believe that the Earth was born out of a giant egg. As legend goes, Baal did not think it was time for his wife to die, so he threw Semiramis back to Earth in an egg. It landed in the Euphrates River. When it cracked open, she turned a bird into an egg-laying rabbit. This is where the Easter bunny originated. Keep in mind, on the matter of Lent, that they were practicing Lent 1,000 years before Jesus. It has nothing to do with the 40 days in the wilderness. The reason we eat Easter ham, is commemorating the wild boar that killed Tammuz. This idea of Easter is a 3,000 year old Babylonian legend. Every single pagan holiday to follow would use this as a point of origin. In Egypt, Semiramis and Nimrod AKA Ishtar and Baal were called Isis and Osiris. In Greece, they were known as Aphrodite and Adonice. Rome</p>
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				<p>called them Venus and Cupid.</p> <p>The symbol of Baal, Ishtar and Tammuz is the Eucharist. It is the crescent moon cradled within the sun shaped monstrance and is in every Roman Catholic Church today. The pine cone staff is also used to symbolize Osiris. The pine cone is a symbol of fertility because it comes from the fir tree because it is green year round. The pine cone is on the largest statue in the Vatican. It is also on the Pope's staff.</p> <p>The trident is another ancient satanic and pagan hand gesture. The trident of Babylon was placed in the hand of all the pagan gods. The pagan statue of Jupiter, in the Vatican, was renamed Saint Peter. He is holding up the trident symbol and it appears everywhere around the world.</p> <p>The crosier is another pagan symbol. It is the staff or cane of the serpent. It is on King Tut's throne. All over the world, the fingerprints of the enemy are present. There is even a winged dragon on the papal crest in the Vatican museum.</p> <p>The sunburst/solar wheel is a Babylonian symbol for the sun god Baal. It is an 8-pointed star or in 8 sections like in a wheel. They are found in Buddhist temples and even in the monastery floor tiles of Saint Ignacious. Where is the largest solar wheel on Earth? The court of Saint Peter at the Vatican in Rome is where it is</p>
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				<p>at. Where do we find the sunburst symbol of Baal today? The sun burst is displayed on department store Christmas trees. It is not representative of the star of Bethlehem. It is the star of the sun god. There is even an 8-pointed star on top of the White House Christmas tree.</p> <p>The word obelisk literally means Baal's shaft or Baal's organ of reproduction. It is another pagan symbol. It is almost always placed in the center of a circle, which represents the female genitalia and the physical sexual act. There is one in Turkey, Cleopatra's Needle in London, Scotland, Paris, France, and Germany. There is one in Mecca, Egypt, Argentina and Mongolia. The largest one is in the Vatican, dead center in Saint Peters' square. It is the exact shape of the Washington monument. It is on many, many churches in the form of steeples and bell towers. The question would have to be where did we get the idea to do this? The early Reformers, when they came out of Rome, removed them as the monuments of idolatry. Martin Luther called the organ an ensign of Baal.</p> <p>When do you think the birthday of Nimrod and Tammuz was? It was the first day of the year when the son is reborn, which is the winter solstice; December 25th. The birthday of every pagan sun god, from every religion is December 25th. The emperor</p>
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				<p>Constantine changed the date in the late 300's to make it easier for the pagan sun worshippers to convert to Christianity. Instead of worshipping sun gods, they now worshipped Jesus. All sun gods, from every religion, might have had different names, but they can all be traced back to the original sun god Baal AKA Nimrod. This day was to celebrate longer days of the sun. The Chaldeans called this day, Yule Day, which means the day of the infant, talking about Tammuz, who was the "son of god" who would one day come back and save them from the world.</p> <p>Along with the celebration of the sun gods, the Scandinavians worshipped Odin. He was the god of intoxicating drink and ecstasy as well as the god of death. He had a long, white beard. Guess who he became? He became Santa Claus. Nicholas, as in Saint Nicholas means mighty one. Nimrod means mighty one as well. Odin was a mighty man with a white beard. He was the god of wisdom, magic and occult knowledge, runes, poetry and war. His name means "the inspired one". He was a tall, old man with a long, white beard and carried a spear/crosier. He is surrounded by ravens and wolves. He traveled around the world on a white horse that had eight legs, which became reindeer. In virtually every version of "Klaus" he carries along behind him a dark helper.</p>
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				<p>They became elves. The main symbol of this mystical being that had godlike powers was the "eternal" fir tree. The main symbol of the true God is the Tree of Life. There is no coincidence that the enemy would use a tree as well. By the 1500's in Holland, he became Sinterklaas, a kind and wise old man with a white beard, red cloak, a crosier and riding the skies and roofs of the houses, on his white horse, accompanied by his Black Jacks, leaving gifts for people under his tree, the fir tree. He would visit you on his birthday, during the winter solstice in December, and give you gifts if you have been good or if you have been bad, his Black Jacks would beat you. By the 1700's a Dutchman immigrated to North America and brought his Sinterklaas with him. In English, it was then "Santa Claus". In the 1930's, a designer for the Coca-Cola company was trying to get people in the winter to buy their drink. They took their company colors, borrowed the Sinterklaas story, changed a few things and out came the modern Santa Claus, complete with reindeer and elves. In the 1600's plays were very big. In the plays, Saint Nicholas was a demon and was portrayed that way. Every time he would come on stage, he would announce himself with these words: Ho, ho, ho. They replaced Odin with Saint Nicholas and got rid of the ravens and wolves and replaced them with reindeer</p>
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				<p>and elves.</p> <p>The question posed was did Saint Nicholas ever exist? In the 1970's the Second Vatican Council formally stated that no Roman Catholic bishop by the name of Nicholas had ever existed. They further confessed that the legends attributed to this "saint" had no Christian origin, and probably came from pagan traditions. The World Book Encyclopedia states, "The belief that Santa enters the house through the chimney developed from an old Norse legend. The Norse believed that the goddess Hertha appeared in the fireplace and brought good luck to the home. Druid homeowners would leave a treat consisting of milk and pastries to appease this god that came down into their chimney into their fireplace."</p> <p>We give children both Christ and Santa Claus. The question posed is who is who in a comparison among the two of them. Consider these facts or myths.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. He has no beginning or end.2. He has his own eternal spirit that he brings to the world when he comes.3. He is all-knowing.4. He judges good and evil.5. He "loves" children.6. Children ask and seek his blessing and favor.7. He writes their name in a book.8. His hair is white as snow. (This is where it starts to differentiate.)9. His hair is white as snow.10. He travels at night.11. He wants to give you everything your flesh desires. (The Father wants to
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				<p>give you everything you need.) 12. He has a mystical tree. So who is who? The Oxford English Dictionary defines devil as the following: is called Satan, Lucifer, and Beelzebub...and in the 1600's was called Old Nick.</p> <p>Where did the Christmas tree come from? Trees have been worshipped by virtually every pagan culture in the world and were again, a major symbol of sun god worship and fertility. Pagans worshipped triangles and pyramids. The obelisk was worshipped akin to this for fertility. The fir tree was utilized as a magical tree because it remained green all year long. It was decorated in some cultures with fruit and other cultures ordained it with 12 candles to honor their sun god. Today, we even sing songs about it, just like they did in their pagan worship rituals.</p> <p>The mistletoe came from the Celtic people as they had long considered mistletoe to have magic powers to heal and increase fertility. The kissing under the mistletoe finds its origins from the sexual promiscuity of the Romans which was common during the Festival of Saturnalia AKA the 12 days of Christmas.</p> <p>The Encyclopedia Americana states the following: Christmas- It was according to many authorities not celebrated in the first centuries of the Christian Church as the Christian usage in general was to celebrate the death of</p>
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				<p>remarkable persons rather than their births. A feast was established in memory of the birth of the Savior in the 4th Century. In the 5th Century, the Western Church ordered it to be celebrated forever on the day of the old Roman feast of the birth of Sol, or the son which was December 25th.</p> <p>This is from the records of the General Court, Massachusetts Bay Colony, on May 11, 1659 it stated the following: To the great dishonor of God and offence to others: it is therefore ordered by this court...that whosoever shall be found observing any such day as Christmas or the like...shall pay for every offence...a fine.</p> <p>Why did Satan go to so much trouble to infuse paganism in the world and why did he take the top 4 events in human history and change their course? He did it to set a foundation of lies and to create a false story. He cannot change the truth, he can only add to it. We cannot be where God wants you to be if we are filled with man-made doctrine and tradition. The spirit of God only comes through 2 things: truth and humility.</p> <p>Can we worship God with anything that is impure or defiled? Can we take the evil and worship God, for in it there is the good? This is not something left for speculation. Leviticus 18:30 says this: Keep my requirements and do not follow any of the detestable</p>
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				<p>customs that were practiced before you came and do not defile yourselves with them. I am the Lord your God. Mark 7:8 says that we are laying aside the commanded word of God; you hold the tradition of man. This is exactly what we have done. Deuteronomy 12: 3, 4 says to cut down the carved images of these gods and destroy their names from that place. You shall not worship the Lord your God with such things. Verse 8 of the same chapter says that every man is doing right in his own eyes. Isn't this right where we are today?</p> <p>Deuteronomy 4:2, 12:29-32, and Proverbs 30:6 tell us not to add or take away from God's word and commandments. We ask God for his power, but are not willing to do anything to get it. What we've done is that we've become complacent and sloppy in the way we serve the Lord. If we remove the lies our ancestors have given us, intentionally or not and pick up the living word of God, then blessings will flow.</p> <p>On December 24, 1871 Charles Spurgeon said that we have no superstitious regard for times and seasons. Certainly we do not believe in the present arrangement called Christmas and...because we find no scriptural warrant whatsoever for observing any day as the birthday of the Savior and consequently, its observance is a superstition because not of divine authority. Rome</p>
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				<p>came into power and forced Christians to worship their way. The Roman emperor Constantine said, "This subject having been discussed, it was deemed to celebrate Easter on the same day...which was the practice in Rome. We should perpetuate to all future ages the celebration of this rite." We celebrate our Savior's resurrection on the exact same day that every pagan for 3,000 years was celebrating: Ishtar's Sunday. Satan's plan was to keep us from celebrating the holidays God told us to keep. He took those truths and mixed it with pagan idolatry. We are putting aside the things of God for the traditions of man. These things may not mean that to you, but they mean it that way to God. Satan is a liar and has been that way from the beginning. His only goal is to present the truth and keep us from growing in God's word, because if we did we would accomplish God's will on Earth. Mark Twain said, "The Christian's bible is a drug store. Its contents remain the same, but the medical practice changes." We must put down the traditions of man and pick up the attributes of God. We are supposed to be set apart for a holy purpose, because we are a holy priesthood.</p>

Here are just a few more items in the healthcare bill that will affect everyone, but primarily the doctors and the disabled. Page 253 states that the government will set the value of a doctor's time. Page 268 states that the power and purchase of power driven wheelchairs will be decided by the government. Lastly, doctors will be held responsible for patients and their admission into care facilities. If a patient is readmitted, the doctor will be penalized. Vaseline, cortisol, etc. are effective in the short term. Antibiotics are routinely used as well. Mrs. Savely went on to talk about Ivermectin, which is an antiparasitic that seemingly shows no side effects with this treatment. Albendazole is helping as well. Steroids and antihistamines are not effective in infection. The diagnosis of a delusional patient, according to Mrs. Savely, should not be done by a dermatologist.</p> <p>Sharlene, a Morgellon's patient since 2006, was diagnosed with Lyme at the same time in 2006 when she was diagnosed with Morgellon's. She was initially diagnosed with 3rd degree burns on her head, which was a wrong prognosis. She has started a support group with nurses, doctors and others afflicted</p>
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				<p>with this.</p> <p>Cindy Casey, an RN for 16 years in the same unit, was a first responder to this program. Doctors did not want to hear about this disease. After visiting 7 or 8 dermatologists, no solution was to be found. Her symptoms include indescribable itching and disfiguring and chronic fatigue. According to Cindy, dermatologists think that this disease is all in her head.</p> <p>Dr. Randy Wymore, an Oklahoma State University professor, came on with 6 characteristics of Morgellon's: skin lesions, crawling sensations, fatigue, "fibers", behavioral effects, and cognitive difficulties. The slow healing lesions are a result of peripheral neuropathy. Additional symptoms include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. CNS effects: cognitive and behavioral changes2. Appearance of red, blue, clear or black fibers in the associated skin3. Delusions of parasites (DOP) or neurotic excoriations. <p>Morgellon's fibers don't pick up stains and currently we are unsure if they're growing as they don't change size or shape.</p> <p>Marc Neumann, an independent researcher in Germany and a Morgellon's patient, has a type of skin fungus, Lyme and is</p>
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				<p>currently battling a lung infection which is associated with this disease. Based on his research, he has concluded, that his disease is a direct result of pesticide induction. Molds from bread, cheese or fruit may attribute to it as well. The skin molds appear to grow in one direction. This may give some clue to where they are originating. Based on his research, the best precautions to prevent this are a ceasing of biological pesticides, like those used by farmers, and insect infestation.</p> <p>Doctor Wymore concluded the program by stating that, according to his research, that Morgellon's is either not contagious or minimally contagious. Over 30 patients have been examined at OSU over the past 5 years without infecting any staff member or student of Doctor Wymore.</p> <p>According to Doctor Arifiles, 64 of the genetic codes that we, as humans, are made up of, contain a lead-based mineral. The state of malnutrition is an epidemic. The reason this is important that our own bodies are substituting a pure mineral for a substitute that is not working as well. By testing for vitamin D and other specific deficiencies, the treatment and possibly the prevention of Morgellon's may lie in boosting the body's own immune</p>

They want the terrorists to succeed. That's the only reason to object to terrorism. A startling fact is that every Islamic organization in America is pro-terrorist. Our government wants and needs to win our hearts and minds. The problem is that our security apparatus that is currently in place has been politicized. There are 3,000 Muslims in our military currently. They are there for translation purposes. There are many, many qualified Islamic translators in the world, but they are never considered because their beliefs may differ from their current translators. This is the political apparatus at work. Shoebat challenged everyone to find even one statement that President Obama has said criticizing his Muslim faith he supposedly left. There are now hundreds of preachers and churches operating in Iran. There are many Iranians who have now fled to Turkey to avoid religious persecution. Mani has brought with him Rahman Salehsafari. He is a Christian brother who lives in Turkey and has had a radical conversion. He lives his life by Acts 1:8 as we will be God's witnesses in all the world. As an Iranian refugee, he says that's he is having a book of Acts moment as he is being allowed to preach the gospel right now in Texas and the nation. Our</p>

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				<p>God can change anybody. He was born into a poor, but very religious family. He had many financial and spiritual limitations coming from a devout Muslim family. He became a devout Muslim out of tradition and was taught not to ask questions. He had a deep sense of fear of God and family because of the fear instilled into him if he did not follow the Muslim edicts. The nature of God was not the reality of God. When he was young, he was forced to do all of the local obligatory prayers. It was a social disgrace for him if his children did not know and do the obligatory prayers. He thought it was more important to be thought of highly by others because of his children. His father physically abused his mother, brothers and sisters daily. He would lock the door so no one could leave. He felt this god was not the god worth having. He was never taught the love of God and was angry at this god. When he was 13 and still being pushed to do his religious duties, and because of all of his father's abuse, he was disgusted by all religion and his fathers' religion specifically and began to rebel. He even began to pray to God that if he was real to allow him to get back at his father. At 14, he was kicked out because of his rebellion. He felt like this was ultimate freedom, but quickly realized that freedom came at a price. In order to survive on the street, he became a bully to fight back. This was his way to fight back</p>
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				<p>against the violence of society. After leaving town and going where he wasn't known as his fathers' son, he got involved in major gang activity such as theft, extortion and then drug trafficking. His only goal was to move up in the gangs and in the street. He wanted the power and control. He never had a home. At 21, he started his own gang, but it was still not enough, because he was still angry at his father. He entered the Iran/Iraq war to try and release his anger for his father on the enemy. He served 6 years on the front line. It is important to know that this is a war that lasted 8 years and had 500,000 casualties. He served 3 tours of duty and wanted to die. He wasn't afraid of death. He was looking for it. He couldn't understand why good people all around him were dying but he wasn't. After the war, he went back to drug dealing. He felt like he couldn't die and became very bold with his dealings. He banded together seven smugglers and they were merciless; killings or whatever you can think of. They started bringing in hundreds of kilos into Iran. He would make the journey himself. One day, unbeknownst to him, his six, all of his gang members were all caught and in jail and told the authorities everything, including his current trip information. On his way back into Iran, he found the army and military laying a trap for him. He threw hundreds of kilos of cocaine that were in</p>
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				<p>the car with him out the window. By the time they had caught him, he had thrown it all away, but they took him off to jail. After searching his car, all they found was a trace amount in a bag. He denied owning it because under Iranian law, he would be killed for being a drug dealer. He was in solitary confinement for 7 months. During that time he was tortured daily in order to try and get a confession. They would give him electric shocks, hang him upside down and beat him severely. All of his teeth were knocked out and all the bones in his face were broken, but he never confessed. All six of his gang members confessed and were executed at the gallows within 7 weeks. He did not want to be overcome and wanted to die on his own terms and not by anyone else's and certainly not his enemy's. After 7 months, they held him in prison not because of the drug dealings, but because of the murders he had committed. Under Iranian law, the families of the victim were the only ones who could release you. If they said to kill you; you died. If they said throw him in jail; that's where you were and that's where you stayed. If they said forgive him, then he could be set free. He had been on the gallows twice before and right before he was supposed to die the families changed their minds. This went on for six years. During that time, he used his money to have lawyers keep delaying his</p>
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				<p>execution. After 6 years, his wife came and said that she had had enough and she was leaving him. He told her that he could not go on without her and was going to kill himself that night. That night for the first time he became scared of dying. This was right before he was going to inject himself with drugs. After crying for three hours, and this is the first time since he had cried since he was 13, he went to sleep. That night Jesus came to him in a dream. He did not know who Jesus was or even his name. In his dream Jesus told him his name and that he needed to repent and he would be saved from all of this. He had the same dream 13 days later. They moved him from where the murderers and drug dealers were to the area of the prison where the political prisoners were being held. There were two religious leaders there. He told them of his dream and one of them told him that if Jesus told him to repent then he should do that and follow him. It is important to know that this religious leader was Muslim. At this time, he was the biggest drug trafficker in the prison. It brought him power, but he went to his cell and said no more. After 45 days from his first dream he was called to the warden's office where the families of all of the people he had killed were gathered. None of them were related or even knew each other, but they all said the same thing. They had a dream that</p>
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				<p>God had told them to release him or he would bring judgment on them. Three days later, he was released. The day God came to him was when he realized he needed God. After his release from prison, he stayed in Iran for a season but then fled to Turkey with his wife, whom he had now reconciled with, and his daughter. At this time, his daughter had developed paralysis and could not walk. Although God had blessed him in Iran, he had to leave it all there because of the religious persecution he faced. They had nothing. They got involved in a church in Turkey and that is where he was baptized. At this time, his wife held on to her Muslim faith. One day the government came and told them that they had to leave that city. They went to another city where there was no church. God showed him that this was where a great work was to begin. He started a church in his home, along with his daughter and was living completely by faith alone. He had no support from anyone, but God continued to provide. God gave him the verse Isaiah 53:5 which said that we are healed by his wounds. He brought his church and other believers together and they prayed for three hours. That very night his daughter began to walk. It had been 5 years since she had last walked. People came from all over to see this living miracle. The</p>
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				<p>night she walked was the night his wife got saved. The Turkish doctor, who was a Muslim, saw her and got saved. During this time he started many churches in Turkey. He was on fire for God and brought 1,700 people to the Lord and had baptized them all. The Lord started to speak to him and he started working with the Iranian refugees in Turkey. He felt God was telling him to meet the physical needs as well. After spending many years in Turkey, the US opened up his case and welcomed him as a refugee. In America he prayed to know what God's will was. The first thing was to proclaim the gospel. He had been here for 12 months and 6 days and had led 5 Americans to the Lord. These are 5 people who did not speak his language. He would use a translator. The Lord told him to establish a ministry in the US like the one in Turkey. The Lord then gave him a vision of 1,000 partners to help meet the needs of the refugees in Turkey. The next vision was to build a camp in Turkey to aid the refugees. The first church started in Turkey began with 3 people and now they have 110 members. The goal in Turkey is to start 15 additional churches in the remote areas of Turkey. They are meeting the physical needs first and then the spiritual needs. 80 to 90% of the refugees in Turkey are Iranian and the goal is to get the non-believer with the believer and make a connection</p>
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				<p>through the physical need first. There are 18,000 Iranian refugees in Turkey currently. 4,000 of them are in desperate need. There is a great network of churches to help administer aid. One hundred dollars, through this partnering program, will maintain one adult and two children with food for a month. The vision is for food right now. All of the partners are partnering for food. By helping fulfill Rahman's vision Mani states that they are helping fulfill the greater vision of bringing Iranians to Christ. The Lord has a purpose and a plan for all of us. Open our hearts and lift up our hands. If you are tired of mental problems or sickness, lift up your hands and open your heart and the Lord will come in.</p>
